Greater Depth Identify and label the different types of verb in a paragraph without prompts. Sentences include modal, action and linking verbs.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Application or Reasoning)

Developing Find and explain the mistake in a statement. Text includes adjectives, action verbs, proper nouns and adverbs.

Expected Find and explain the mistake in a statement. Text includes abstract nouns, adverbials of time, modal verbs and adjectives.

Greater Depth Find and explain the mistake in a statement. Text includes adjectives, comparative adjectives, modal and action verbs, proper and abstract nouns, and adverbs.
