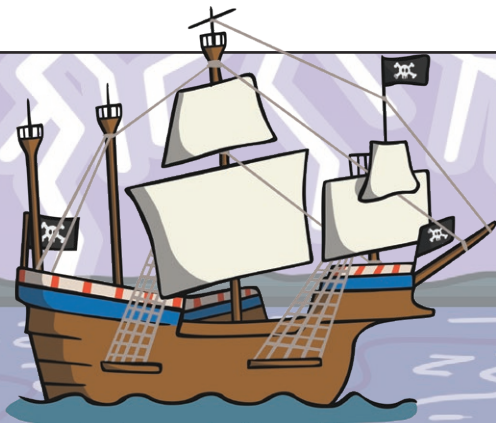

2. How might Stefan have been feeling at the start of the story? Give evidence from the text.



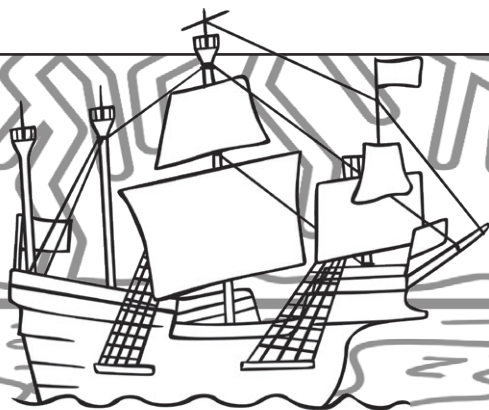
