Dear Parents,

We hope you had a lovely Easter, and that the children are ready and raring to go for the final term of year 4!

We are very excited for what is coming up with our new driver 'Ancient Civilisations'. The historical aspect focuses on Ancient Egypt and the Sumer, with Geography being based around North and South America and UK transport links. The at home requirements are the same this term – reading the designated pages from their group reading book, times tables daily (this can be found on our class page) plus a weekly maths and English activity. It is also great preparation for meeting the expectations of years 5 and 6. With this in mind, we will be spending some of our lesson time on Friday marking the homework sheets as a class. This will allow me to address any misconceptions and begin to prepare the children for expectations in Year 5.

Our PE sessions will remain on Mondays and Thursdays – each of these sessions will be outside.

This term we have lots of fun things going on:

- Our annual multi-cultural week will be the last week of summer 1
- Year 4 Multiplication Check will take place during the first half of June
- There will also be our usual sports day and end of year activities towards the end of this academic year
