To earn a badge you will need to do a few more tasks...

Choose any of the following tasks, the more you do the more points you earn and the more chance you have of earning a badge.

Binocular Build: Tape two toilet roll tubes together and attach a piece of string. Decorate them with "camouflage" patterns (greens and browns) so you are ready to spot lions on a safari!

2 points

Foil-Wrapped Fish: Cut a fish shape out of a cereal box. Wrap it tightly in kitchen tin foil, smoothing it down with your fingers. Use Sharpies or felt-tips to draw colourful scales and fins on top of the silver—it creates a beautiful, shimmering "scale" effect!

2 points

Rock Pool Stones: Find a smooth pebble or stone and turn it into a sea creature using paint or felt-tip pens. Can you make it look like a crab, a fish, or even a sparkly mermaid?

3 points

The Life of a Bug: Build a "Bug Hotel" in your garden or an outdoor space using twigs, pinecones, dry leaves, and hollow stems. Check back a few days later—who has moved in?

3 points

Beach in a Box: Use a shoe box or a tray to create your own mini-beach. You could use sand (or flour/salt), blue paper for water, and real shells or stones you've found.

5 points

Animal Masks: Choose your favourite safari animal—maybe a roaring lion or a tall giraffe. Use a paper plate or some card to make a mask so you can "become" that animal.

5 points

The Ultimate Safari Guide: Create a "Safari Guide" poster. Choose one wild animal and draw a big picture of it. Around the picture, add "Facts" (parents can help scribe or you can draw symbols) about what they eat, where they sleep, and what their skin or fur feels like.

10 points

Journey to the Deep: Build a 3D underwater scene using an old cardboard box. Paint the inside blue and hang "swimming" fish from the top using string. Add some "seaweed" made from green paper or fabric.
