Choose any of the following tasks, the more you do the more points you earn and the more chance you have of earning a badge.

2 points

Write about a memorable experience you have had at school - Describe what happened and explain why it was important or memorable to you, then draw a picture to match your account.

2 points

In honour of Queen Victoria and the era of nature studies, create a coronation crown using craft materials and natural objects such as long grasses, flowers and twigs.

3 points

Plant, care for and grow a sunflower - Take photos and keep a record of its growth. I wonder how tall it will grow before the summer break?

3 points

Design an outfit for a 'poor' person and a 'rich' person to wear in Victorian times. Then create a backstory for each individual, including their name, age, where they live, and what job they do.

5 points

Explore somewhere outdoors; it might be the woods, a field, the beach, or even your back garden. Then, write a senses poem about nature using imaginative descriptions. You could start with prompts such as: "I can see... I can hear..."

5 points

Swap your gadgets for a Victorian game - Get creative and make a traditional Victorian toy; perhaps a board game like Snakes and Ladders, a spinning top, or even a thaumatrope!
