Explain your answer.

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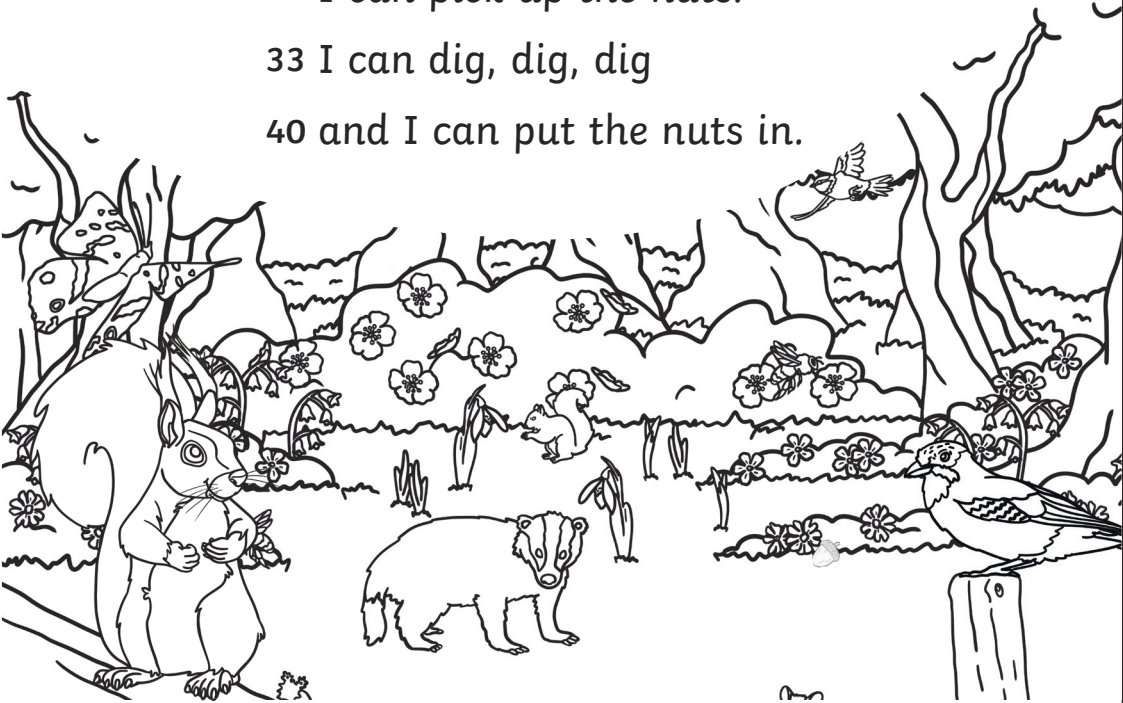
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Answers



1. Can you think of a way to describe the sun?

Pupils' own responses, such as: The sun is yellow; The sun is orange; The sun is hot.



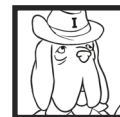
2. How many nuts can be picked up?

Pupils' own responses, such as: I think a squirrel is picking up the nuts because squirrels like nuts and they hide them to eat in the winter.

Pupils' own responses, such as: I think the nuts are put in the ground because the text says I will dig and put the nuts in.
