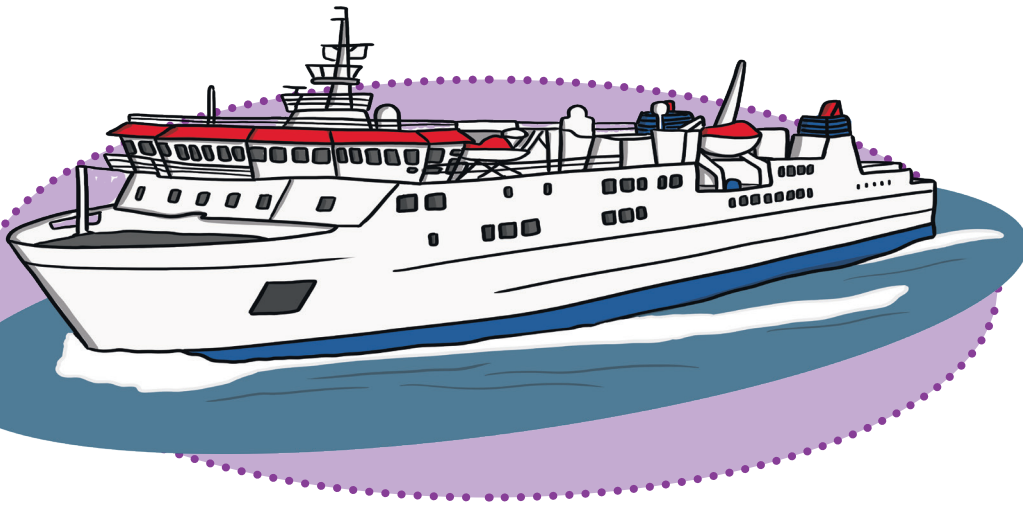


The Ship to Cork

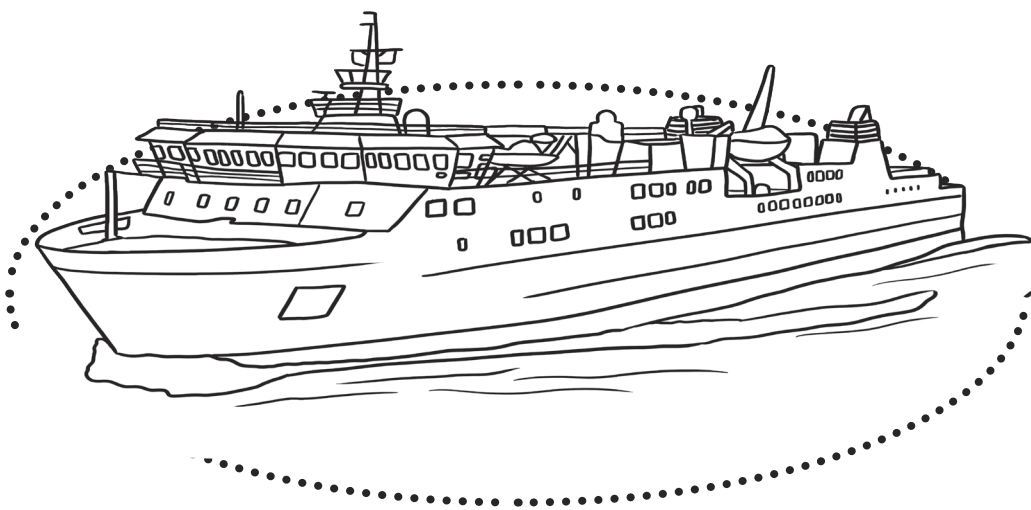

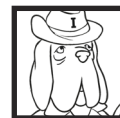
