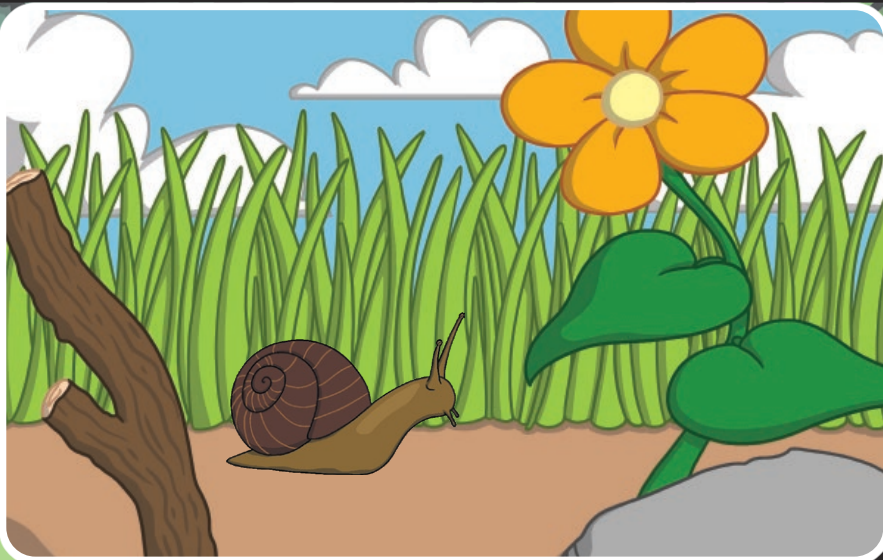


Slugs and Snails

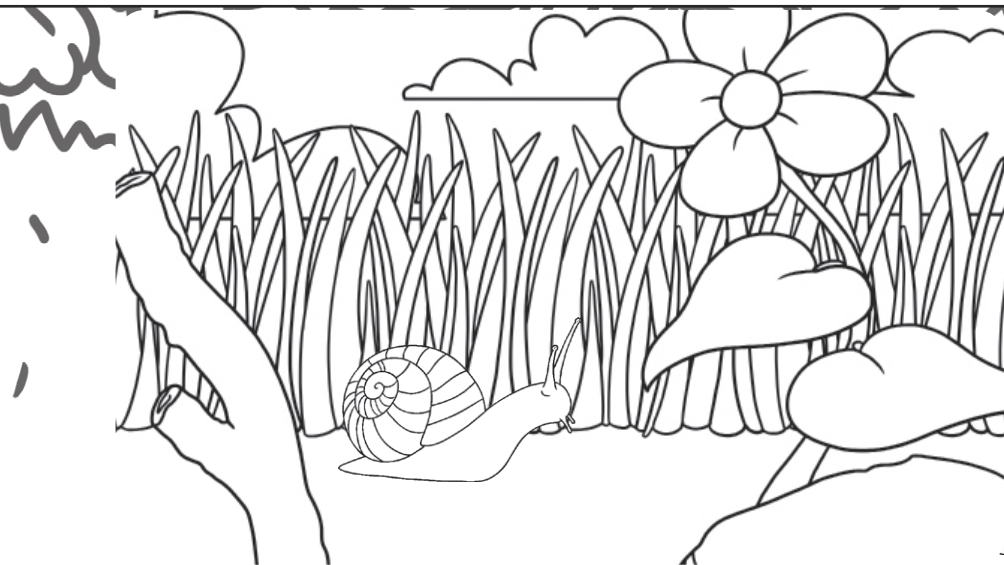

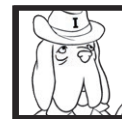
